Temporary Closure of Urban Footpath F1090/140

TAKE NOTICE that in pursuance of Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, the County Council of Somerset have made an Order **PROHIBITING ALL PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC** from proceeding along **Urban Footpath F1090/140** from the **junction with Lime Street, south-westwards** for a distance of **50 metres**.

This order will enable Somerset County Council to carry out construction of a new footway on Lime Street adjacent to footway access.

The Order becomes effective on 09 October 2017 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **12 February 2018** and last for **4 weeks**. While the closure is in operation an alternative route will be signed on site.

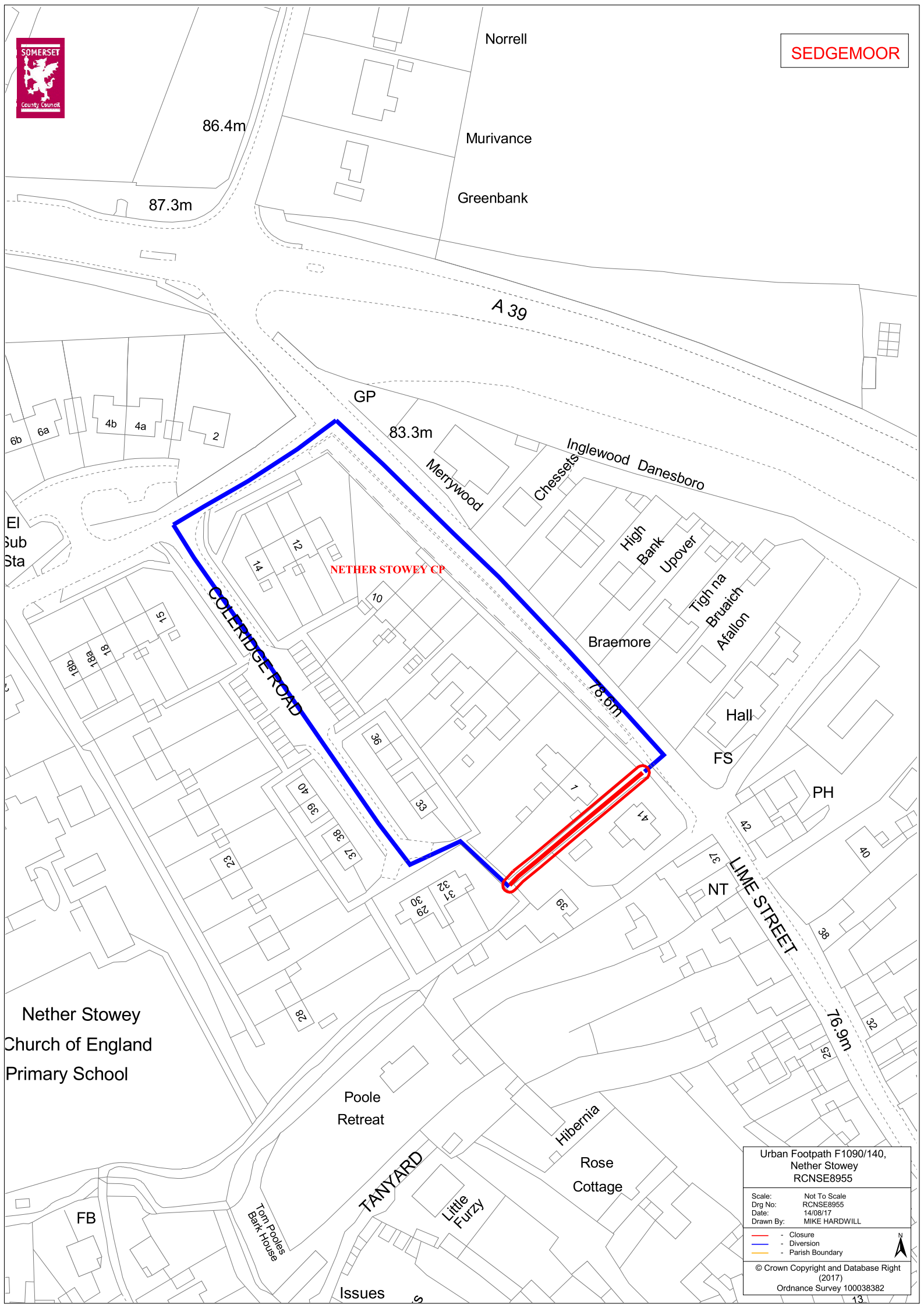
