



THE THOMAS POOLE LIBRARY IS RE-OPENING!

We are excited to announce that plans are under way to reopen the Thomas Poole Library on Monday 17th August.

The service offered will be mornings only and on a reduced "Personal Shopper" basis.

***Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays 10am – 1pm.
Saturdays 10am -12.***

Books should be requested in advance, preferably on the Somerset Libraries' dedicated service. Alternatively, you can email neslib@somerset.gov.uk with your request or telephone during opening hours on 01278 732741.

Please note that items can only be supplied from our own library stock – the interlibrary loan service is not available.

There will be a one-way system in operation which will be clearly signposted and someone will meet customers at the front door to advise on the new system. Customers will be asked to wait for their books in a socially distanced waiting area.

There will be no access to the main library and browsing will not be allowed to reduce the risk of infection.

Returned books will be quarantined for 72 hours before discharging and return to the shelves.

We ask that you wear masks to protect our volunteers, but this will not be insisted upon.
